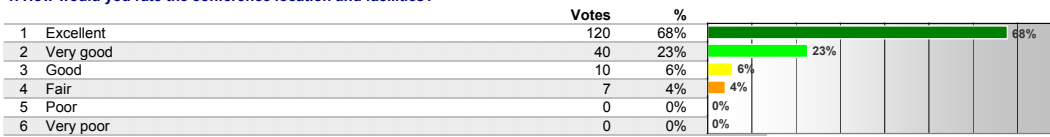

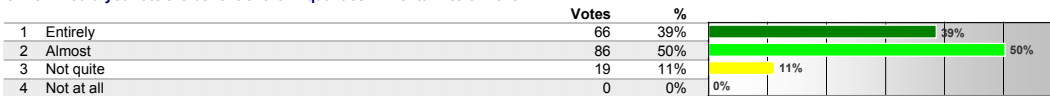
1. How would you rate the conference location and facilities?



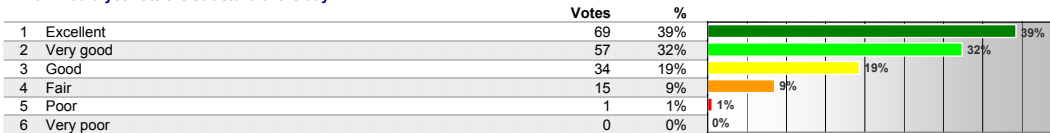
2. To what extent do you feel the "Equalities in Mental Health 2010" has delivered its aims?



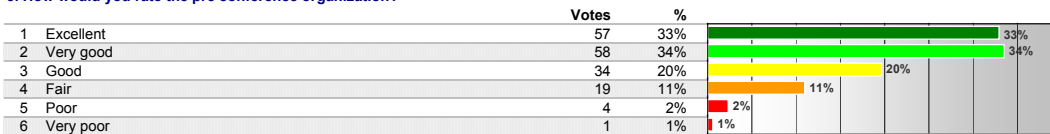
3. How would you rate the benefit of the "Equalities in Mental Health 2010"?



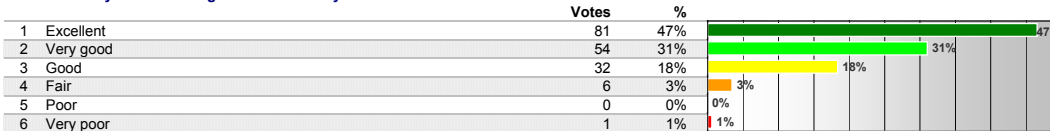
4. How would you rate the structure of the day?



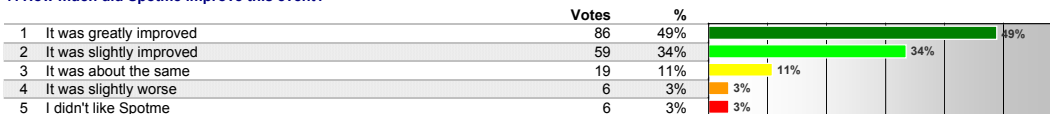
